Essential Functions: *(This job requires the performance of the following tasks, with or without accommodation. Incumbents may be regularly or occasionally required to assume additional responsibilities or perform additional tasks.)*

- Maintain an awareness of items that may need a second cleaning.
- Scrape and rinse cooking pots and pans prior to a thorough cleaning.
- Store clean cookware in designated areas.
- Scrape and rinse dishes, glassware, and eating utensils prior to washing them.
- Store serveware in designated areas.
- Assist other kitchen staff by retrieving items from the refrigerator, freezer, and storeroom.
- Maintain a clean and sanitary work station.
- Assist other staff in end-of-day cleaning tasks.

Qualifications:

- A friendly, positive attitude.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Ability to communicate clearly and kindly with co-workers, supervisors, manager, and visitors.

Work schedule: April-October, mid-morning through mid-day with weekends and occasional evenings required. November and December, during Gardens Aglow, Thursday through Sunday evenings.

Physical and environmental factors: The work is performed in a kitchen, exposed to heat, cold and wet conditions. Requires standing for six hours at a time, climb stairs, and lift/carry 40lbs.
